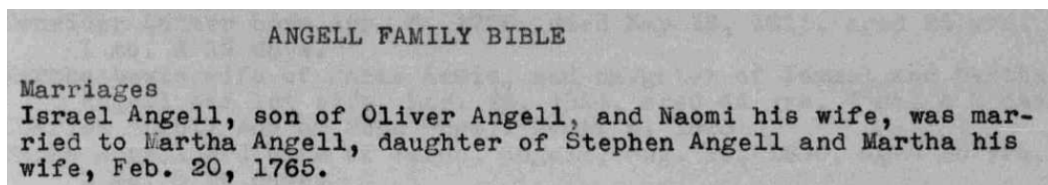

Eleazer Arnold was the son of Thomas Arnold and Phebe Parkhurst of Suffolk County, England then Watertowne, Boston. Thomas and Phebe's ancestry is a bit uncertain. A will written in 1644 by Richard Arnold, a goldsmith in London, is providing more Arnold/Parkhurst history. Eleazer's birth to Thomas and Phebe is in *Massachusetts town clerk vital and town records 1626 - 2001* at FamilySearch.org and *The genealogical dictionary of Rhode Island* by Austin. Eleazer married Eleanor Smith, their marriage is in *Torrey's New England Marriages before 1700*. Eleanor's dad was 1 of 6 John Smiths in early Providence, so Eleanor's parents are also a little iffy and records are probably mixed up.

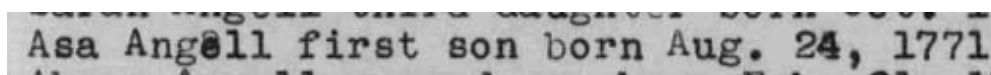
Elizabeth Arnold was Eleazer and Eleanor's daughter. Elizabeth's birth is in *Historic homes and institutions* by Bicknell and Eleazer's will in *The early records of the town of Providence volume 16 page 213* "daughter Elizabeth Smith" showing her marriage to Israel. Elizabeth and Israel's marriage is also in *Vital record of Rhode Island 1636-1850 a family register for the people* by James Arnold.

Naomi Smith was Elizabeth and Israel Smith's daughter. Naomi's birth is in *The ancestry of Emily Angell* and *Vital record of Rhode Island 1636-1850*. Naomi, Oliver and family are in several sources being parents of American Revolution Colonel Israel Angell, the subject of at least 2 researched family history books.

Israel Angell's birth is in *Vital record of Rhode Island 1636-1850*. Israel and Martha's marriage is in several sources, snapshot shows *Rhode Island Births and Christenings 1600-1914* at FamilySearch which is actually the transcribed Angell Family Bible.



Asa Angell was the son of Israel and Martha with his birth in *Roger Williams of Province, R. I.* (a source for the *Roger Williams Family Association*) and the same Angell Family Bible. Israel and his son Asa were both on on August 24th. Asa's marriage to Cynthia Hill is in *Mayflower families fifth generation descendants 1700-1880* because Cynthia's ancestors are John and Elizabeth Tilley Howland of the Mayflower.

I.* (a source for the *Roger Williams Family Association*) and his marriage to Clementina Benight is in *Indiana marriages 1811-2007*. Their children are in Dexter's will *New York, Wills and Probate Records, 1659-1999*.

Delia Angell was the daughter of Dexter and Clementina. Delia is in Dexter's will and her parents are listed on her death register record in *Iowa deaths and burials 1850-1990*. Delia and William Flood's marriage is in *Iowa county marriages 1838-1934*.

Matilda Flood was the daughter of Delia and William. Matilda's birth and parents are in *Iowa death records 1904-1951* and local newspaper sources. Matilda and Richard Mockford's marriage is in *Iowa county marriages 1838-1934* and on their daughter Philippa's birth register in *Iowa county births 1880-1935*.

Philippa Mockford was the daughter of Matilda and Richard. Philippa's birth register has her parent's names. Philippa married Harve Speedy. Their lives are documented in several excellent sources and 1st hand personal knowledge. Philippa and Have shared an October birthday and hosted surprise parties for each other
